 - 3.Plot the points E (4 , 2) , F (0 , 2) , G (-1 ,3) and H (2 , 0) on the Cartesian plane. Join these points in order . Name the shape thus obtained. What value is predicted from this action?
 - 4.PQR is a triangle in which $\angle Q > \angle R$ and M is a point on QR such that PM is the bisector of $\angle QPR$. If the perpendicular from P on QR at N, then prove that $\angle MPN = \frac{1}{2} (\angle Q - \angle R)$.
 5. ABCDE is a regular pentagon and bisector of $\angle BAE$ meets CD at M. If bisector of $\angle BCD$ meets AM at P, find $\angle CPM$.
